Terms & Conditions

Candidates must be under 19 years of age and in full time school education on 26 November 2017.

Concert standard dress or school uniform is required for both rounds of the competition.

The top three in each category will agree to make themselves available for the afternoon final at 5pm in Wellington School Great Hall.

Two photocopies of each piece to be performed must be submitted on the day.

The expenses for the trip to Steinway Hall in London will cover the winner of the advanced class only.

The winner will be required to perform at Steinway Hall as part of a recital to include professional artists, which will be tailored accordingly.

The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

The competition will be held at various venues at Wellington School. Wellington School is a co-educational day and boarding school in Wellington, Somerset. There are 800 pupils from ages 3 – 18 years.

As part of Wellington School's strategy to continue to develop a centre of excellence in the expressive arts, the Music Department took delivery of 15 brand new Steinway pianos in September 2010.

As a result of the partnership with Steinway, Wellington School is designated an All-Steinway School.

Class	Standard Maximum	Performance Time
Foundation	Grade 4/5	3-6 minutes
Intermediate	Grades 6/7	5-8 minutes
Advanced	Grade 8+	8-10 minutes

The first round for each class will be held in the Small Hall, George Corner Music School at Wellington School. Each competitor will play the Steinway Model B Grand Piano.

The best three pianists from each section will perform in the Piano Competition

Finals Concert at 5pm that afternoon at Wellington School.

The finals prizes are as follows:

Foundation:	£75 plus the Piano Competition Foundation trophy
Intermediate:	£125 plus the Piano Competition Intermediate trophy
Advanced:	£200, the Piano Competition Advanced Trophy and an all expenses paid trip to perform at Steinway Hall in London.
